Tan Tara Jr. Golf Club Rules & Guidelines

Open to all children 7 through 17 years of age. Dress code: All juniors must wear neatly pressed shirts and shorts. Shorts must be mid-thigh length. No tee shirts or cut off shorts permitted. All juniors must always follow the Tan Tara Jr. Golf Club code of ethics.

Treat others as you would like to be treated. Replace divots, rake bunkers, and repair ball marks so you leave the course better than you found it. Club throwing, swearing, cheating, derogatory comments, and littering are not acceptable. Always thank the volunteers. Have fun and smile. Professional staff reserves the right to remove any junior camp members in violation of these ethics from the program as they see fit.

VOLUNTEER CHAPERONES

Adult helpers are both needed and welcome. We urge you to help at least 2 times this year. If you cannot, try to arrange for another adult to help. Due to the high volume of swing theory and practice, we ask that while on the premises, volunteer chaperones enforce good conduct and professionalism but do not attempt to critique golf swings.

LEVELS OF INSTRUCTION

We offer 4 levels of instruction based on age and ability. This ensures that each student gets the most out of the program. Here is a brief description of each level:

3 Holers – These juniors have little or no course experience. They will play 3 holes per session with the tees approximately 100-150 yards from the hole. Instruction begins at 10:00 AM.

6 Holers – These juniors have basic instruction in full swing, short game, putting, course rules and etiquette. They will play 6 holes per session from the red tees. Instruction begins at 9:00 AM.

9 Holers – These juniors have played 9 holes and score in the range of 55-75. They will play 9 holes from the red tees. Instruction begins at 8:00 AM.

18 Holers – These juniors have played 18 holes before and score on average 110 or better. They will play 18 holes per session and tee off from the red or white tees. Instruction begins at 7:00 AM.

LESSON FORMAT

Each session begins 45-minute lesson, with a time slot based on each child's level of instruction. Following the lesson, the junior campers play their designated number of holes on the actual golf course.

We will be reviewing everything there is to know about golf, including: etiquette, rules of the game, speed of play, and most importantly, the golf swing.
